

1. IDENTIFY THE STUDY PROGRAM AND PERIOD

Before starting the nomination process, please make sure you have all the following details:

- What semester? (Autumn, Spring, or full year)
- What study program? (see course catalogue on page 1)
- What language of study? (English, French, or Mixed)
- * For students coming for one semester, please make sure there are no exam or semester dates conflicts with the home university.
- * We strongly recommend master students to come for the autumn semester or whole year.
- * There is no 1^{st} or 2^{nd} year at Grenoble IAE at Bachelor level.

3. STUDENT NOMINATION

4. APPLICATION PROCESS AND DOCUMENTS

Once students have been nominated they will receive by email the link to the application form with a list of the required documents that will be uploaded on the platform. The partner university will be in copy.

5. DECISION

Students and coordinators will be informed of the final decision by email (see deadlines on the calendar).

Students that have been selected will then receive all the necessary information for their stay at Grenoble IAE, starting with the housing information.
